Option A: Includes tuition for five courses, program activities, excursions, and shared apartments.	\$ 15,472.



Option B: Includes tuition and fees for four courses and academic internship, program activities, excursions, and shared apartments. \$ 14,962.

Option C: Includes tuition and fees for four courses, program activities, excursions, and shared apartments \$ 12,872.

Spring: Food Culture & Food Media in Italy

Fees **Spring 2020**

Option C: Includes tuition for four courses + academic internship, program activities, excursions, 5 days outside of Rome, and shared apartments. \$ 15,722.

Internship in Rome

1 month - \$ 4,706, 2 months - \$ 7,335, 3 months - \$ 9,690, 4 months - \$ 11,241

Internship out of Rome but within Lazio region

1 month - \$ 4,848, 2 months - \$ 7,623, 3 months - \$ 9,978, 4 months - \$11,529

Internship in other regions of Italy

1 month - \$ 5,576, 2 months - \$ 9,108, 3 months - \$ 12,349, 4 months - \$13,251

OTHER PROGRAM RELATED FEES - ITALY PROGRAMS

Item	Amount
After notice of acceptance, a non-refundable down-payment is required to commit to the program. This will be deducted from the program fee.	\$400
Insurance: All students are required to enroll in a select insurance policy.	Varies between \$ 100 and \$ 300 based on program length.
Fee for hard copy visa or other support letters sent through international shipping, if requested.	\$ 40 - 100, estimated.
Single room housing supplement. On request, upon availability (in addition to regular housing fee)	Starting from \$ 500.
A housing deposit is due on receipt of apartment keys.	\$200

OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES - ITALY PROGRAMS

All students should anticipate additional expenses. These will vary considerably based on your



personal needs and choices. Typical students will encounter the following additional expenses (may vary depending on exchange rates).

Item	Estimated amount
International Transportation	\$ 1,000
Books and supplies	\$ 200
Food	\$ 140/week
Miscellaneous Personal Expenses- Estimates of out-of-pocket expenses reported by prior students.	\$ 100/week

CANCELLATION POLICY - ITALY PROGRAMS - OPEN ENROLLMENT

A total refund (excluding the \$400 non-refundable deposit) will be made if a student withdraws 60 days before the beginning of a program.

A 50% refund (excluding the \$400 non-refundable deposit) will be made if students withdraw from 30-60 days before the beginning of a program.

No refunds will be made if withdrawal is made within 30 days of the beginning of a program.

Upon arrival in Italy, no refund will be made for any reason whatsoever in case the student decides to cancel, change or vacate the assigned housing.
