The Hobart and William Smith Colleges Fall 2019 study abroad program in Rome is a full immersion experience that uses the whole city as a classroom. Students will gain a broader perspective on Italy's history, culture and daily life through interdisciplinary courses, field studies and short excursions. Professor Leah Himmelhoch, Faculty Leader, will teach the course "An Ancient Tourist's ' Rough Guide ' to Visit Imperial Rome.

Students will also take two courses designed by Gustolab International. "Italian Food and Culture" is an experiential learning course focusing on food identities and multiculturalism in Rome.
